



**REGULATIONS**  
**of the contest «Field kitchen»**

## I. General Regulations

1. The Army International Competition of Food Service Specialists "Field Kitchen" (hereinafter - the Competition) is held as part of the Army International Games (hereinafter - the Games).

2. The general management of the Competition preparation and implementation is entrusted to the organizer of the Competition - the management (food) of the Resource Support Department of the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation.

In agreement with the organizer of the Competition, the Competition may be held by the **co-organizers of the Competition (in other territories of foreign countries)**.

3. The objectives of the Competition are:  
strengthening of international military and military-technical cooperation of the participants of the Games;  
enhancing the prestige of military service;  
improving the level of field training of participants;  
development of combat training competition;  
demonstration of capabilities (tactical and technical characteristics) of samples of military and military-special equipment (hereinafter - MMSE).

4. Place of the Competition:  
shall be determined by the organizer of the Competition in accordance with the decision of the Minister of Defense of the Russian Federation in the year preceding the Competition, but not later than the beginning of the year of the Competition, indicating (training ground, military unit number, location).

5. To participate in the Competition, teams from among the military personnel are involved (confirmed by the identification card of the military personnel).

It is forbidden to participate in the Competition of military prize-winners - members of teams (cooks, bakers) who took I,II,III places in the corresponding specialty in the past years (*for example: a soldier took I,II,III place among cooks, he is allowed to take part as a baker and for circulation*).

The composition of the team (delegation) - up to 11 people:

senior team (member of the judicial commission) - 1;

team coach (field referee) - 1;

Participants:

cook 2, spare 1;

baker 2, spare 1;

technical personnel - 2 (in fire training competitions do not participate);

translator - 1 (from the country of the participant).

### Reference:

*The minimum number of participants in the competition may be 5 people, including:*

*senior team (member of the judicial commission) - 1;*

*representatives of the Competition team (2 cooks and 2 bakers).*

6. Replacement of participants is allowed 1 time **before the start of competitions** (stages of the Competition) in case of unforeseen circumstances, independent of the contestant (suspension due to medical indicators, official or family circumstances, etc.).

If during the competition (stages of the Competition) someone of the participants fell ill or for some reason unable to continue the competition (suspended from participating in the Competition, etc.), further replacement of the team is not carried out (the team continues to participate in the Competition in reduced composition).

7. The clothing of the team (participants in the competition) must be uniform and include:

- field uniform of clothing;

- special form of clothing for cooks and bakers (cook's cap, cook's jacket, cook's trousers, cook's apron, cook's towel, shoes, disposable gloves);

- special uniform for technical personnel (headgear, jacket, trousers, shoes, gloves);

- senior team, team coach must have cook jackets;

- sports clothing (for cultural and leisure activities and sports and mass events).

8. For cooking and baking bread and bakery products in the field during the Competition in the Russian Federation use: portable PP-40 stoves, portable kitchens

PK-30, kitchens hook-on KH-130, hook-on baking HB-0.4 blocks (according to the decision of the organizer of the Competition or from his consent, technical means of food service for all participants of the Competition can change on more advanced).

For cooking and baking bread and bakery products

in the field, when conducting the Competition outside the Russian Federation, in agreement with the organizer of the Competition, technical means (technological equipment) provided by the co-organizer country are used.

Reference:

*For objective evaluation, all participants of the Competition must perform on the same type of equipment (process equipment), the same according to tactical and technical characteristics.*

Commands are allowed to use technical means (technological equipment) of cooking, bread baking and bakery products (similar to the technical means declared in the position according to the method of heat heating (operating on liquid (diesel) fuel using nozzles or similar technical means (technological equipment) presented by the country co-organizer).

Permission for the use of technical means (technological equipment) is given by the judicial commission after comparing the tactical and technical characteristics by voting of all members of the judicial commission.

Reference:

*When using technical means (process equipment)*

*A reduction factor of 50 points shall be applied at the stage of performance that does not correspond to the tactical and technical characteristics.*

9. The competition is held during the Games in three stages (regardless of the number of participating countries):

**the first stage of the Competition** - "Fire Training Competition";

**second stage of the Competition** - "Food Preparation Competition and baking bakery products according to an arbitrary recipe from a set of products issued by the organizers of the Competition";

**the third stage of the Competition** - "Food Preparation Competition and baking bread in accordance with the menu and recipe determined by the organizers of the Competition."

10. On the opening and closing day of the Army International Games (by agreement) the "Master Class" of preparation of national cuisine by the Competition teams is held "(in the rating table not taken into account).

The "master class" of preparing national cuisine by the Competition teams "is held with the aim of:

familiarization of participants and guests of the Contest with dishes of national cuisine of the participating countries;

showing the level of professionalism and qualifications of participants;

showcasing the possibility of cooking a variety of tasty

and healthy food in the field;

exchange of experience, technology of preparation of national dishes

and improving the culinary skills of military personnel;

possibilities of tasting prepared dishes of national cuisine.

## **II. Management of the Competition Preparation and Implementation**

11. For direct management of the comprehensive provision of the Competition (determination of the start time, and the end of cooking during the Games), the organizer (**co-organizer**) of the Competition, determines the personal composition of the Competition administration.

12. Provisions on the Competition are developed and approved by the organizer of the Competition (management (food) of the Department of Resource Support of the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation), all amendments to the provisions are made only by the organizer of the Competition or with its consent.

13. For objective refereeing of the stages of the Competition, a judicial commission consisting of: the chief judge of the Competition, the secretary of the Competition, the assistant secretary of the Competition, members of the judicial commission of the Competition and field arbitrators - one representative each from each state taking part in the competition (senior teams, coach) with translators (by agreement).

The Secretary, Assistant Secretary of the Competition are appointed from among the most trained military personnel from the country of the organizer (**co-organizer**) of the Competition.

Field arbitrators are appointed to each place of cooking from among trainers of the countries of participants by carrying out draw.

The field arbitrator (trainer) can't be appointed to the team from the country of promotion.

Reference:

*A field arbitrator (coach) from the Russian Federation cannot be appointed as a field arbitrator to a team from the Russian Federation and so for all states.*

14. The judicial commission of the Competition shall be entrusted with holding the Competition in accordance with this Situation and situation on holding of the Contest judging, determination of results and summing up of the Contest results.

15. All violations are subject to video fixation (established by the organizers (co-organizers) of the competition) or recording comments by field arbitrators with confirmation (photo, video materials) to discuss controversial issues when assessing the quality of cooked dishes, bread and bakery products by members of the judicial commission.

Materials provided by other persons to the consideration not accepted.

### **III. Procedure and conditions of the Competition**

16. The official motto of the Competition: "I ate well - I succeeded in battle!."

**Prior to the Contest:**

17. Send a written appeal to the organizer (**co-organizer**) of the Contest on confirmation of consent to participate

in the Competition not later than **3 months** before the opening of the Games (for quality planning and preparation of comprehensive support of the Competition).

18. Submit the Lists of participants of the Competition and copies of identity cards (military tickets) of military personnel, **45-30 days** before the opening of the Games, in form (*No. in order, position by competition, military rank, last name and patronymic (if any), date of birth, No. Identification card (military ticket) of the military personnel*).

19. Arrival of the Bidding States at the Place and their placement is carried out no later than 10 days before the opening of the Competition, the departure of teams to permanent locations on territory (no later than 3 days) after awarding the winners or holding a "Class Master" for the preparation of national cuisine (as agreed).

During the period of arrival before the start of the Competition:

all quarantine events established by the organizer (co-organizer) country (at least 3 days) if necessary;

arrival, placement and registration of teams participating in the Competition;

medical examination of the Contest participants, including delivery of the necessary analyses provided by the legislation of the organizer (**co-organizer**) of the Contest for cooks and bakers (*in-depth medical examination with permit to work on food preparation, and before the beginning of each day of the Competition, a medical examination of the participants of the Competition is carried out*);

Reference:

*participants of the Competition who have not passed a medical examination and instruction on safety measures are not allowed to participate in the Competition and its stages.*

familiarization with the program, procedure and conditions of the competition;

submission of **updated written** applications by team leaders, for participation of personnel from the state in the Competition;

familiarization with the technical means (technological equipment) of the food service involved in the competition;

Drawing of lots to determine jobs

(if necessary, group numbers in the divisions of each Competition participant team);

acceptance of equipment and equipment to be used during the Competition;

holding of classes by the Contest organizers (**co-organizers**) on operation and safety requirements with Competition teams;

preparation of technical means for operation, their testing;

preparation of teams under the guidance of coaches;

weapon firing (*number of cartridges per participant not less than 20 pcs.*);

1 training cooking of food and bread baking (*provided by products at the expense of the receiving party*),

if it is necessary to increase the number of training sessions, products are purchased at their own expense (*at the expense of the guide side*) in agreement with the host party;

cultural, leisure and sporting events (*if enough time is available*);

training of the opening ceremony of the Competition (*with the participation of representatives of foreign teams according to a separate calculation and harmonization*);

preparation of teams for the "Master Class" on preparation of national cuisine by the Competition teams (by agreement, if necessary).

### **During the Competition:**

20. Teams are allowed to participate in the Competition, ensuring timely submission of applications for participation in the Competition, readiness and arrival within the prescribed time.

21. With participation in the Competition, **9 teams or more** Teams participating in the Competition are divided into two divisions, based on the participation rating of previous years.

### **Reference:**

*The first division includes teams of states that occupied I, II and III places in past Field Kitchen competitions since 2016.*

*When establishing the best result by the teams of the second division, compared to the teams of the first division, next year they are allocated to 1 division to participate in the Competition (and vice versa for the teams of the 1st division).*

*All judges of the states who have arrived to participate in the Competition take part in the refereeing of each division.*

If necessary (if 12 teams or more participate) or it is not possible to act simultaneously to all participants of the Competition (at the stage of the Competition), teams of divisions at the II and III stages take turns, the teams of the

second division are the first (the decision to apply the method of performance according to the established position of the queue is made by the judicial commission by voting).

Awarding of winners of I, II and III places is held in the first and in the second division.

Reference:

*When calculating the state rating in the Games, the results of 2 divisions not taken into account.*

22. With participation in the Competition of **8 teams or less**, divisions are not created.

Only winners (teams) taking I, II and III places are awarded.

If necessary (justified), by drawing lots, teams are divided into two groups, the II and III stages of the Competition are held in groups (the decision on dividing into groups is made by the judicial commission by vote).

Reference:

*All states (judges) who have arrived to participate in the Competition take part in the judging of each group.*

23. During the first stage - "Fire training competition" the level of fire training of each representative of the Competition team is determined with the corresponding number of points in the rating table of the Competition.

The first stage is held at the site for shooting from a machine gun. The area for firing from the machine gun is equipped with directions for shooting, the initial border, the border of opening fire, places for firing from the machine gun, the procedure for choosing the firing line and weapons is determined by drawing lots.

Representatives of the Competition team at the first stage at the command of the shooting manager perform the shooting exercise "Shooting from a place on a fixed target during the day."

*Targets for machine gun firing:*

*thoracic figure with circles (annex No. 6) on the shield 0.75 x 0.75 m., stationary;*

*The range to the target is 100 m.*

*The number of cartridges is 13 (3 firing, 10 control shots).*

*Targets for machine gun firing:*

*thoracic figure with circles (annex No. 6) on the shield 0.75 x 0.75 m., stationary;*

*The range to the target is 100 m.*

*The number of cartridges is 13 (3 firing, 10 control shots).*

*Shooting time: unlimited.*

*Position for firing: lying from the stop (from the hands).*

*Type of weapon: AK-74 assault rifle (or its analogue) with an open mechanical sight.*

*When the Competition is held outside the Russian Federation, in agreement with the organizer of the Competition, small arms provided by the co-organizer country are used.*

Reference:

*When using small arms that do not meet the tactical and technical characteristics (different from the organizer (co-organizer) provided by the country at the stage of implementation, a reduction factor of 50 points is applied.*

Features of firing.

When performing shooting exercises, the personnel of the participants are equipped with body armor, a steel helmet, and a undercut for stores.

The presence of instructors in the firing area during control firing is prohibited.

The exercise is performed by two series of single shots (three shooting shots and 10 test shots per set). After execution of the first (shooting) series of shots, the representative of the judicial commission of the Competition brings the participant of the Competition to the target and marks the hit. In the second (control) series of shots, the participant of the Competition performs an assessment exercise, while the target is examined at the end of the shooting at the command of a representative of the judicial commission.

For getting into the central circle (diameter 10 cm.) is charged 10 points, for getting into each subsequent circle the number of points decreases by 1 (10, 9, 8, 7, 6- Appendix No. 6).

If there is a direct hit of the bullet, the hole that broke the circle line is counted in favor of the shooter.

Order of points in the rating table:

Points are awarded by the representative of the judicial commission of the Competition after inspection of the target. The inspection is carried out together with representatives and participants of the teams of the First Stage Competition - "Fire Training Competition," who performed the shooting exercise.

Points are entered in the rating table in the amount equal to the sum of points (control shots) awarded to all representatives of the Competition team obtained as a result of hitting the target using a lowering factor of 4.

24. During the second and third stages of the Competition - "Competition in the teams for cooking, baking bread and bakery products" defines the level of professional training of representatives of the Competition teams with the corresponding number of points in the rating table of the Competition

(The rating table contains the number of points obtained by summing up the results assessed by all members of the judicial commission and dividing by the number of members of the judicial commission participating in the rating.)

25. For cooking and baking bakery products at the second and third stages of the Competition, participants are given food necessary for cooking, baking bread and bakery products in accordance with the list determined by the organizers of the Competition.

Features of the second stage of the Competition - "Competition for cooking and baking bakery products according to an arbitrary recipe."

For cooking, participants of the competition are given food (1 of 2 options to choose from) by drawing lots, necessary for preparing cold snacks, 1, 2, 3 dishes in accordance with the list (variant) determined by the organizers of the Competition (Appendix No. 1, No. 2).

To bake bakery products and pie, participants of the competition are given food (1 of 2 options to choose from) by drawing lots in accordance with the list determined by the organizers of the Competition (Appendix No. 4).

Before the beginning of cooking (baking bakery products), participants in the competition draw up a menu (list of bakery products) within 15-20 minutes and are presented in a sealed envelope in the judicial commission (dishes (products) prepared for bonus points are not prescribed).

On the first day, each team prepares one cold snack, one 1st dish, one 2nd dish (meat portion with side dish), one 3rd dish (drink) from the food set issued to the participants by the organizers of the Competition for 20 portions of each dish (Appendix No. 1).

On the second day, each team prepares one cold snack, one 1st dish, one 2nd dish (fish portion with side dish), one 3rd dish (drink) from a food set issued to participants by the organizers of the Competition for 20 portions of each dish (Appendix No. 2).

On the third day, each team bakes bakery products from at least three types of dough (yeast, sand, layered, etc.) according to an arbitrary formulation at the rate of at least 15 types (small pieces are prepared at least 5 pieces each) and 1 pie (weighing at least 1100-1200 gr.) Established by the organizer of the Competition (drawn from a black box) by drawing lots.

Reference:

*Bakery products from yeast fresh dough and yeast dough, regardless of complexity, are evaluated as one type of dough.*

*Products prepared in the form of pancakes and sand cookies - for small-piece bakery products are not considered (except if pancakes or sand cookies are used as one or more components of this product).*

The list (variant) of the set of products, determined by the organizer of the Competition, should be used to prepare dishes and bake bakery products **in a mandatory manner**.

For prepared dishes (products) in excess of the assigned amount, bonus points are awarded (5 points for each dish (product) taking into account item 25 of the provision on the procedure for judging the Competition).

Reference:

*All prepared dishes presented by the team are evaluated and bakery products, including dishes (bakery products, etc.), prepared additionally in excess of the established standard.*

*Bonus points are awarded to the team if the prepared additional dishes (cold snacks, 1, 2, 3 dishes (drinks), desserts, bakery products, etc.) meet the conditions and quality requirements of the finished dish (appearance, color, taste and smell, consistency, completeness, complexity and design).*

*When baking bakery products, 5 bonus points are awarded for each type of dough prepared in excess of the established situation standards.*

***Features of the third stage of the Competition - "Competition for cooking and baking bread in accordance with the menu and recipe determined by the organizers of the Competition." Features of the third stage of the Competition - "Competition for cooking and baking bread in accordance with the menu and recipe determined by the organizers of the Competition."***

For cooking, the participants of the competition are given the food necessary to prepare the established list of dishes in accordance with the menu version determined by the organizer of the Competition (Appendix No. 3).

For bread baking according to the specified recipe and caravan, the participants of the Competition are given food in accordance with the list determined by the organizers of the Competition (Appendix No. 5).

On the first day, each team prepares food according to menu option No. 1 according to the prescribed recipe: one cold snack, one warm snack, one 1st dish, one 2nd dish (meat (fish) portion with side dish) and one 3rd dish (drink) for 20 portions of each dish (warm snack for 10 portions).

On the second day, each team prepares food according to menu option No. 2 according to the prescribed recipe: one cold snack, one warm snack, one 1st dish, one 2nd dish (meat (fish) portion with side dish) and one 3rd dish (drink) for 20 portions of each dish (warm snack for 10 portions).

On the third day, each team produces bread baking at the expense of for 12 loaves of bread weighing at least 1.1 kg and not more than 1.2 kg and 1 caravan weighing not less than 2 kg and not more than 2.1 kg.

26. Distribution of variants (sets of products) for cooking or baking bread and bakery products is carried out on the day of the stage of the Competition by the method of drawing lots.

27. Start and end time of cooking, bread baking and bakery products, presentation of cooked food, baked products for evaluation, shall be determined by the judicial commission before the start of the stage of the Competition.

Reference:

*No more than 4 hours are allotted for cooking, for baking bread and bakery products for no more than 6 hours.*

28. In the period of cooking in specially equipped places, the presence of persons who are not part of the representatives of the Competition team (cook, baker, technical support group and field arbitrators) is not allowed, including the judicial commission.

On cooking days, only the composition of cooks is involved and technical staff from the participating country.

On the days of baking bread and bakery products, only the composition of bakers and technical personnel from the country of the participant are involved.

In order to control and ensure the safety of equipment operation, one representative is present in specially equipped places on the days of stage II and III competition from the technical personnel from the country of the organizer (co-organizer) of the Competition.

29. For cooking and baking of bakery products on "Master class" the participants of the Competition independently buy necessary food at the expense of the directed party (proceeding from existence in retail chain stores in the territory of the organizer (**co-organizer**) of the Competition, or use, the food brought from the territory of the state **with obligatory documentary confirmation their qualities and safety** (certificates or certificates of quality, veterinary certificates, etc.), at the rate on thirty people).

#### **IV. Duties of the Participants**

30. Participants are obliged to:  
know and comply with the requirements of this Regulations;  
submit to the Competition and its stages by the specified time, carry with it the corresponding document confirming the identity of the soldier;  
be in the places reserved for the participants and observe the schedule established for the Games;  
unquestionably follow the instructions of the judicial commission of the Competition;  
comply with safety measures and rules for handling weapons and when working on cooking equipment.

The management team of the Competition shall not have the right to simultaneously join the judicial commission (field arbitrators) of the Competition and participate in this competition.

31. The team leader (representative from the state) of the Competition is responsible for a condition of military discipline, observance by members of the team of the Competition of rules of the Competition, safety requirements and performance of a daily routine.

He is obliged to:

submit to the judicial commission of the Competition the documents stipulated by this Situation by the specified term;  
to stay permanently at the Place of the Competition, to leave only with the permission of the senior judge of the Competition or the person replacing it;  
inform the Contest team about the decisions of the Contest judicial commission, changes in the day schedule and detailed competition program;  
submit additional applications to the judicial commission of the Competition, timely report on the members of the Competition team dropping out from the Competition for the conclusion of a doctor or for other reasons;  
know the results shown by the members of the Competition team, summarize the results of the performance of the members of the Competition team for the day, set tasks for the following days;  
attend the meetings of the judicial commission of the Competition and the draw.

32. Senior team of the Competition is forbidden to make decisions on withdrawal of members of the Competition team without additional application and notification of the Contest judicial commission.

#### **V. Program of the Competition**

##### ***First day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;  
training on safety requirements;  
the opening ceremony of the Competition (Games) (with the participation of representatives of arrived foreign teams by separate agreement).

"Master class" on preparation of national cuisine by the Competition teams for 30 people (the time of readiness is set by the Competition administration);

delivery of ready food to participants and guests of the Competition (Games);

summing up for the day.

***Second day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

training on safety requirements;

holding the first stage - "Fire training competition";

summing up the results of the first stage of the Competition;

preparation of food service equipment involved in the competition.

***Third day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

training on safety requirements;

holding of the second stage of the Competition "Preparation of dishes according to an arbitrary formula "(meat dishes);

evaluation of quality of cooked bakery products dishes;

delivery of ready-made food to visitors and participants of the Competition;

summing up the results for the day;

Maintenance and training of the food service equipment involved in the competition.

***The fourth day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

training on safety requirements;

holding of the second stage of the Competition "Preparation of dishes according to an arbitrary formula "(fish dishes);

evaluation of quality of cooked bakery products dishes;

delivery of ready-made food to visitors and participants of the Competition;

summing up the results for the day;

Maintenance and training of the food service equipment involved in the competition.

***The fifth day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

training on safety requirements;

holding of the second stage of the Competition "Preparation of dishes according to an arbitrary formula "- Bakery pastries. "

evaluation of quality of prepared bakery products;

delivery of finished products to visitors and participants of the Competition;

summing up the results for the day;

Maintenance and training of the food service equipment involved in the competition.

***The sixth day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

training on safety requirements;

holding of the third stage of the Competition - "Preparation of dishes in accordance with the established menu "according to variant No. 1.

evaluation of prepared dishes;

delivery of ready-made food to visitors and participants of the Competition;

summing up the results of the third stage of the Competition;

Maintenance and training of the food service equipment involved in the competition.

***Seventh day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

training on safety requirements;

holding cultural and leisure events, visiting sights, museums, exhibitions (by agreement).

***The eighth day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

training on safety requirements;

holding cultural and leisure events sports holiday (by agreement) holding cultural and leisure events sports holiday (by agreement).

***Ninth day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

training on safety requirements;

holding of the third stage of the Competition - "Preparation of dishes in accordance with the menu "according to option No. 2.

evaluation of prepared dishes;

delivery of ready-made food to visitors and participants of the Competition;

summing up the results of the third stage of the Competition;

omaintenance and preparation of food service equipment involved in the Competition.

***Tenth day of the Competition:***

medical examination of the Competition participants;

briefing on security measures;

holding of the third stage of the Competition - "Bread baking in forms according to the recipe. "

evaluation of baked bread quality;

delivery of ready bread to visitors and participants of the Competition;

summing up the results of the third stage of the Competition;

Maintenance and training of the food service equipment involved in the competition.

***Eleventh day of the Competition:***

The work of the judicial commission on summarizing the results of the Competition, filling in the rating tables, determining the winners of the Competition.

***Twelfth day of the Competition:***

closing ceremony of the Contest "Field Kitchen," awarding winners.

**After the end of the Competition on the thirteenth day:**

departure of participants to the PPD.

During the closing of the Games "Master Class" on the preparation of dishes of national cuisine, the departure of teams in territory is carried out after the fourteenth day (completion of the "Master Class").

**Reference:**

*if necessary, the organizer of the Competition shall have the right to specify and change the Competition Program (according to the time and dates of the Competition) taking into*

*account the number of teams arriving to participate in the Competition or adverse weather conditions.*

## **VI. Procedure of Determination of Winners and Prize-Winners of the Competition**

33. the winners and prize-winners of the Competition shall be determined by the decision of the judicial commission of the Competition on the total number of points scored by the participants during the Competition.

The quality of cooked dishes, small-piece bakery products and bread is determined in accordance with the requirements of this situation and established requirements in the provision on the procedure for judging the Competition.

34. The final place in the rating table of the Competition for each team in the division (group) is determined by the number of points scored for each stage of the Competition.

The number of points received by the participants of the Competition is the main criterion determining the place occupied (place in the division).

35. When two or more teams of the Competition receive an equal number of points, teams that receive more points for practical actions take advantage in determining the place for cooking according to the established menu.

If again there was equality, then the higher place is taken by the team, which received more than quantity of points for practical actions on baking bread and caravan.

## **VII. Procedure for Filing Protests**

36. A protest against the results recorded at the end of the Competition stages, as well as the actions of the Competition judicial commission, shall be submitted to the senior teams of the Competition in written form in Russian (English if necessary) languages on the day of the Competition stage before approval of the corresponding results.

37. The protest shall be written in the name of the Chief Judge of the Competition and submitted to the Secretary of the Competition.

38. The protest in an arbitrary form indicates the content of the disputed issue, the time and place of the contested results of the competition, actions (decisions) with the application of photo and video materials fixing the disputed results of the competition, actions (decisions) requiring consideration by the judicial commission of the Competition.

39. Taking the decision on protest judge commission has to listen to explains of both persons who submitted protest and against whom a protest has been lodged. The decision can be taken in advance if concerned persons did not attend.

40. Decisions on protests are made by open voting by a majority of votes of members of the judicial commission of the Competition present at the meeting. At the same time, the Chief Judge of the competition does not take part in the voting.

41. If the number of votes is the same, then in this case the Chief Judge of the Competition has the right to vote. The advantage is the half in which the Chief Judge of the Competition voted.

42. The decision made by the judicial commission of the Competition, which does not suit the applicant, may be appealed in the same manner to the judicial commission of the Games.

43. An oral or written statement may be made to the representative of the contest organizer on matters relating to the organization of the Competition.

44. The application shall be made orally by the team leader directly during the Competition, not later than 1 hour after the case causing dissatisfaction.

45. If an oral statement cannot be allowed and requires further analysis, the team leader should state request in a well-founded written protest.

46. Protests affecting the determination of results for the day or stage of the competition, the judicial commission considers within a day from the moment of submission of the protest and no later than the signing of the protocol for the day (stage) of the competition.

47. The decision of the judicial commission is considered adopted if there is a quorum and at least 70% of the members of the commission participate in the work, it must be drawn up by a protocol and reported to the applicant.

48. Judges have the right to voice only a collegial (after voting) decision of the judicial commission, drawn up by protocol. Once a decision has been taken, the Chief Justice (s) cannot express views on contentious issues.

49. The decision is final and binding on all participants.

50. The meeting of the judicial commission of the Competition is drawn up by a protocol, approved by the Chief Judge of the Competition, which is then presented to the Competition teams.
